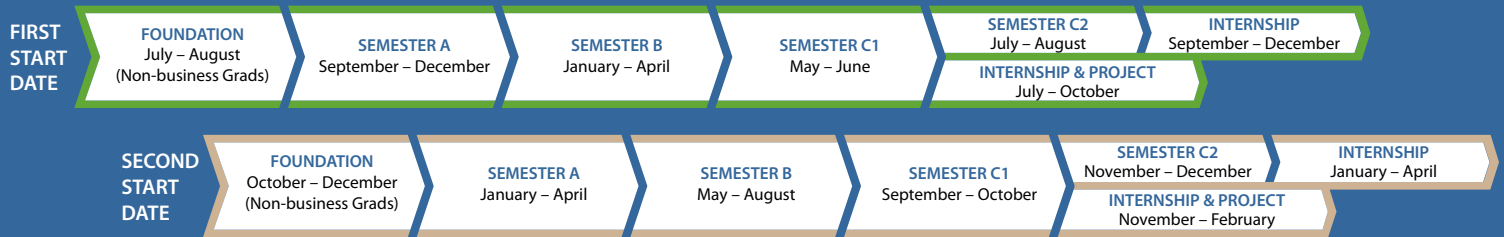

Structure

Vancouver Island University's MBA/MScIB Dual Degree program is offered in an intensive 14-16 month, full-time format which includes a 4-month Internship and Applied Business Project. Students without an undergraduate degree in business are expected to complete an additional 2-month Foundation Program before the start of the MBA/MScIB program. Students choosing the Marketing or Finance option will not do the Applied Business Project.



Internship

Students complete a 4 month internship in the final 4 months of the program. Our MBA internship coordinators provide training to prepare students for the job market, for career success and connect students to internship opportunities.

Options and Applied Business Project

Each student can choose to take the Financial Services option, the Marketing option, or complete the Applied Business Project. Students choosing the Financial Services and Marketing options take two additional courses (for a total of 4 in the option area) over a 7 week period in semester C2. Students who choose the Applied Business Project do a combined internship and project commencing after the completion of semester C1.

Cost of Living

The average cost of living including housing, food, local bus transportation and medical insurance is \$800-1000 per month.

- Letter of intent, résumé, and 2 letters of reference from past employers or professors must be included as part of the application

GMAT and Graduate Record Exam (GRE) score accepted but not required.
