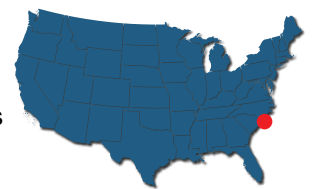

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Students must meet one of the following criteria

- TOEFL: Average score of 75-85 (*minimum of 71*)
- IELTS: Average score of 6.0-6.5 (*minimum of 6.0*)
- SAT Critical Reading score of 450 or higher
- ACT 20 or higher on the Reading section
- Complete Level 4 in UNCW's ESL program
- Two college-level courses of English composition at a U.S. college or university with a "B" or higher (transfer only)
