Maryam Salari is from Iran. She came to study at Vancouver Island University in 2015 and was anxious before her arrival. "I was a bit scared about the type of professors I would have. "I could share my vulnerabilities, my perspective and they understood how I felt." Maryam currently works as an instructor, teaching English for academic purposes at the University of Toronto. She has permanent resident status and is waiting to write her Canadian citizenship exam. To those students who may be thinking of pursuing their education in Canada she says, "jump...take the leap...it will be unforgettable."
