<p>Double Degree Program</p>	<p>The double degree program is intended for master's students who are already in an advanced semester of their master's degree or are an alumni from IU. The newly established international partnership between National University in San Diego and IU provides IU students with the opportunity to acquire an additional, American master degree in addition to the German degree earned at IU. The double degree at National University can be obtained by students in the Master of Business Administration (MBA) program. The double degree program can be completed by participating in online courses from your home country or you can study on campus in San Diego, California. Of course, also a combination of online and on-campus courses is possible. At National University, students take one course per month. Courses start in the beginning of each month, which means that you can start your additional degree any month from anywhere you want.</p>

Academic Year	The unique “one-course-per-month format” enables students to choose flexible start dates and complete their studies in an accelerated time frame as well as to focus on each subject thoroughly.
Orientation	The mandatory orientation day usually takes place one week prior to the start of the first course.
Exam Period	Each course requires a midterm exam after 2 weeks and an end of term exam at the end of the course/ month. Both will take place on Saturdays.
Grading System	Final grades are determined by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Essays, tutorials, presentations and group work as well as written final exams and/or projects • In-class participation
Application	For a successful application, please register via our online application portal and upload the following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of English proficiency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - TOEFL: 79 - IELTS: 6.0 - Language certificate for German applicants (DAAD) with level B2 or higher - Cambridge Certificate Level C • Official Master transcripts in English (stamped and signed by transcript issuing institution) • Bachelor diploma and transcript in English (stamped & signed by transcript issuing institution) • Choice of courses (Non Degree Form, stamped & signed by home institution) • Valid passport copy • Financial statement form + bank letter showing proof of 4,187 USD per course (only needed if you want to study in San Diego)
Application Deadline	Application documents should be uploaded at least 4 to 6 months prior to the preferred course start date, if you wish to study on campus. Online students can hand in their applications 2 months prior to their preferred starting date.
Visa	To study abroad in the US, you need a visa category F-1. Students can request a visa only after their application is approved and after receiving their I-20 form. Online students do not need to apply for a visa.
Accommodation	Living with a host family: starting at 740 USD per month. Living in a student residence (shared room): starting at 860 USD per month
Scholarships/Funding	The European office of National University awards scholarships on a regular basis. Find more information about our scholarships at: www.international-student-office.org/en/how-to-pay-for-study-abroad/scholarships-usa/ Further stipends are being offered by the DAAD, Fulbright Commission and other organizations in your home country.
Health Insurance	Health insurance is compulsory for a study abroad term in the US and must be arranged before departure; it is not needed while studying online.
